

# What is **Destination Imagination**?

Destination Imagination is a fun, hands-on system of learning that fosters students' creativity, courage, and curiosity through open-ended academic challenges in the fields of STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics), fine arts, and service learning. Teams showcase their solutions at a local tournament with the possibility of advancing to additional tournaments if they qualify. **Participating in the local tournament is a mandatory requirement. The 2024-2025 tournament will be held on February 22, 2025 at The Woodlands High School.** 



## The Team A DI team is a



group of between 2 and 7 members that work together to develop a solution to one of our Team Challenges.

## The Team Manager



The Team Manager is an adult (often a parent or teacher) who teaches the creative process and helps keep the team on track, but does not assist or interfere with the team's solution.

## The State Challenge Season

Teams form and begin meeting in September. They typically spend 2-6 months developing their Team Challenge solutions and practicing Instant Challenges leading up to the DI tournament where teams present their Team Challenge solutions and solve an Instant Challenge for feedback and scores.

# Who can participate?

#### Grades 1 & 2

These students participate in the Early Learning category which is the non- competitive division that only has one challenge available. While this group is not eligible to advance past the regional tournament, they do get to participate in the local tournament and it is a great introduction to DI.

#### Grades 3 - 6

Students will compete at the elementary or middle school level. Teams consist of up to seven members and a team challenge can be selected out of six different categories (technical, scientific, fine arts, improvisational, engineering, and service learning). ## When are DI meetings?

Teams typically meet weekly through February at the location, day, and time determined by the team manager. It is important for all team members show up and participate at each meeting.

## What are therequirements?

There is a \$35 per student registration fee and you can expect to pay an additional \$50 for materials (approximate) depending on the challenge your team decides to solve. Every student must have an adult that is able to commit to volunteering.
